I would like to thank last year's board and officers, who served with me, for all of their efforts. This same courageous group with the addition of Stephen Sickerman, will continue to guide the congregation next year. It was also announced that although Rabbi Wasserman will not be leading us, we will be continuing to conduct our normal weekend activities at least once a month. We will have a lay-led service on Friday evening of the second weekend of every month which will be preceded by a pot luck Shabbat meal. On Saturday we will conduct a Lunch & Learn at noon and Saturday evening there will be a Havdalah service on the beach at sunset, followed by dinner at a restaurant.

As we are starting a new fiscal year, we need volunteers to bring the entrée for the pot luck dinner. We also need volunteers for leading and/or participating in services. If you feel you can't lead a service but wish to participate in leading part of the service, please contact Mary Starkman, Ritual Chair and she will ensure that you are included.

It was decided that we would hire a Rabbi rather than a Cantor to lead the congregation for the High Holy Days. The board has started the search process by placing an ad in the Atlanta Jewish Times and an open position announcement on the website of the Central Conference of American Rabbis (CCAR).

Obviously there is more information to follow. Again this year we need your help, both financially and through your service. Membership pledges do not cover our entire expenses. We need volunteers to create and execute one or more fund raisers. This is a critical component of our existence and we have not done a good job in this area. Growing our membership is also a critical part of the plan. Each of you is an ambassador of this Temple. Please be active in this role. Also, this year we ask that you be as generous as possible, within your means, and to pledge more than the basic amount. All of the committees of our congregation need your support and help. Together we can resolve our issues.

# **RECAP OF 2018 TBI ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING**

The TBI Board held its Annual Congregational Meeting June 17th to elect a slate of officers and trustees and review the past fiscal year and present plans and budget for the coming fiscal year. It was at this meeting too, that we said "good-bye and thanks" to our wonderful Rabbi Alana Wasserman.

President Mike Starkman gave his report to the gathered members citing past successes and underlining current and future challenges we must tackle. Namely, the need to host a fundraiser to increase the temple's income in order to keep our shul afloat. We are also in need of growing our membership, and possibly increasing our membership dues. Mike also thanked individual members for their volunteer services enabling all of us to celebrate Jewish holidays, enjoy Shabbat with prayer, Torah, Havdallah, and giving our kids a Jewish education, etc.

Mike, who also acted as Temple Treasurer over the past year, presented the shul's budget. Because of budget shortfalls we will not be able to hire a Rabbi to lead us throughout the year, albeit part time. We should be able to engage a Rabbi or Chazan for the High Holidays though. Members in attendance voted to search for an available Rabbi for the HHD's who can hopefully lead us in song. Mike will begin the search with two Reform Jewish organizations.

The new board was installed by Sarah Farkas, our immediate Past President. She congratulated them, thanked them for their service to our temple and wished them a successful year. Sarah was belatedly presented a token of appreciation for her service as President of the Temple.

The meeting closed with an emotional farewell from Rabbi Alana, who thanked the congregation for welcoming her to TBI and making her a part of our family. The Board presented the Rabbi with gifts of love and gratitude wishing her well in her new home in the Northeast and in her new part time pulpit in Connecticut. We learned much from her and will miss her greatly.

## Tish'a B'Av: A Time of Reflection

On July 21-22, Jews will remember the suffering and hardships that have historically befallen our people. Originally, this "holiday" was meant to memorialize the first and second temples and remember their destruction. But Reform Jews have broadened the meaning of the day to include many tragedies in our history, including the Crusades, the expulsion of Jews from Spain, the Holocaust and more. Unfortunately, there are way too many such events in our history and in the history of the world. It is now customary for Reform Jews to include the suffering and tragedies of peoples throughout the world like those in Darfur, South Sudan, Rwanda, Syria, Central America and many more. We read from the Book of Lamentations, recite/chant dirges called kinot from the Middle Ages. This is also a day of fasting and mourning. Tisha B'Av is a solemn time of reflection.
