TBI Welcomes New Member Families


Please join us in welcoming two families new to Temple B'nai Israel.

We are so fortunate to have Margo as our ISJL fellow. Her Shabbat service was filled with singing and joy. Her voice lifted the congregants up. Margo is incredibly smart and yet humble. She is an awesome leader. One day, she will be a cantor. Her home is Aspen, Utah. Influenced and supported by two professors with whom she studied, Margo connected with ISJL, an organization that is giving her the opportunities which will help her on her journey to be a cantor.

Lunch and Learn was the most interesting Jewish Adult Education Experience I've had since attending Weekends at Camp Jacobs in Utica, Mississippi. Margo was well-prepared. The topic was an examination of paintings of Lilith and Eve, two females that through time have been criticized as Harlots or Heroines. Through leading, thoughtful questions, the attendees determined whether the paintings ascribed characteristics

of a harlot or of an heroine. We decided that the term "harlot" was not applicable because of its denotations. The program is part of the Adult Education programming that ISJL offers. On Sunday, the children were so lucky to have Margo work with them. She danced and sang with them, teaching Chanukah songs to prepare the children for Chanukah. When I finally arrived at Temple, Margo was just winding up dancing Israeli dances with Jackie, Lizzie, and Ari. Then, we made mini torahs in honor of Simchas Torah.

It was a very full weekend for Margo and for those of us who had the opportunity to get to know her!
